

## Resuscitation Protocol – 136 Suite, Penn Hospital

Level of Response	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The staff working in the 136 suite will provide Emergency Life Support when initially responding to the emergency</li> <li>Staff from Dale ward will provide an Immediate Life Support response on their arrival at the scene</li> <li>Staff working with children will provide Paediatric Emergency Life Support (PELS) level of response and will be supported by the ILS team using paediatric modifiers</li> </ul>
What test calls are in place?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Annual external simulation will be undertaken</li> <li>Other simulations and practice drills will be co-ordinated by the matron as required</li> <li>Dale ward also has an annual external simulation undertaken</li> </ul>
Assistance is summoned in a non-clinical area by:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Verbal call for help</li> <li>Activation of staff personal alarm, this will lead to response team from all ward areas</li> <li>Physically going to summon help from Dale ward if this cannot be summoned verbally</li> </ul>
The emergency number is:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>9-999 for West Midlands Ambulance Control</li> </ul>
The staff who will respond to this call will be:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Staff working in the clinical areas will respond and provide Emergency Life Support /Paediatric Emergency Life Support</li> <li>Staff from Dale ward will provide an Immediate Life Support response on their arrival at the scene</li> </ul>
Equipment is kept:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Immediate Life Support equipment (Blue) bag and AED are located in Clinical Room on Dale ward</li> <li>PELS equipment will be kept available for children when they are present on 136 Suite. The exact location will be determined by the team working there</li> <li>A sign indicating the location of the emergency equipment are located outside the Clinical Room door.</li> </ul>
The equipment will be brought to the emergency by:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A team member identified by the person initially responding to the emergency</li> </ul>
The person responsible for leading the emergency once all of the team are available is:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Immediate Life Support Provider responding from Dale ward</li> </ul>
The role of the other team members will be:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Delegated by the Team Leader on arrival at incident</li> </ul>
Access to the building will be by:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Internally from the 136 suite door off the shared therapy corridor</li> </ul>
The team / ambulance will gain access to the emergency by:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Member of staff allocated by the Team Leader to meet the ambulance crew and to escort them to the location of the emergency</li> </ul>
The person responsible for completion of Datix is:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Team Leader</li> </ul>
The incident, for audit purposes will be reported to:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Service Manager and Matron</li> <li>Duty nurse</li> <li>Full list on datix form</li> <li>On Call Manager out of hours</li> </ul>
The next of kin will be informed by:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Team Leader</li> </ul>
Debriefing will be by:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Team Leader</li> <li>Staff welfare inc psychologist</li> <li>Staff support</li> </ul>
