## Contacting the Infection Prevention and Control Team

### You must contact the Infection Prevention and Control Team if:

- You are concerned about an infection prevention and control practice in a ward/department.
- You suspect there may be an outbreak of infection in your area e.g. diarrhoea, vomiting, flu-like illness affecting patients and/or staff.
- You suspect a patient or staff member has an infectious disease e.g. chicken pox, influenza, scabies or tuberculosis.
- A patient/staff member is unwell and has a history of recent foreign travel or pyrexia of unknown origin.
- You plan to purchase new furniture or equipment for a clinical area
- You have any queries about how to prevent or control the spread of infection.
